


Lockdown Battleships

Lightly shade lines of squares on the grid to position your fleet of battleships (horizontal or vertical, except for the submarine - see the example)

You each have:

- One aircraft carrier – 5 squares in grey
- Two battleships – 4 squares each in green
- One submarine – 4 squares in a T-shape in orange
- Three destroyers – 3 squares each in blue
- Two patrol boats – 2 squares each in pink



The example grid shows the following ship placements:

- Aircraft Carrier (Grey):** A 5x1 vertical line from row 9 to row 13, column D.
- Battleship 1 (Green):** A 4x1 vertical line from row 8 to row 11, column E.
- Battleship 2 (Green):** A 4x1 vertical line from row 8 to row 11, column F.
- Submarine (Orange T-shape):** A 4x1 vertical line from row 4 to row 7, column B, with a horizontal line of 2 squares at row 5, columns A and B.
- Destroyer 1 (Blue):** A 3x1 vertical line from row 6 to row 8, column G.
- Destroyer 2 (Blue):** A 3x1 vertical line from row 4 to row 6, column H.
- Destroyer 3 (Blue):** A 3x1 vertical line from row 4 to row 6, column I.
- Patrol Boat 1 (Pink):** A 2x1 horizontal line at row 1, columns D and E.
- Patrol Boat 2 (Pink):** A 2x1 horizontal line at row 1, columns F and G.
