

Christmas Drawing Game

Activity for any sections Estimated to last 20 minutes Resources – young people will need to have a pen/ pencil and some paper

Christmas drawing game – try it with your eyes closed! Have one of your young leaders or young people read out the instructions

- Draw Santa's sleigh in the middle of your paper
- To the left of your sleigh, draw a pine tree
- It's snowing, draw snowflakes in the sky
- Put some ornaments on your pine tree, now it's a Christmas tree!
- Draw Santa on your sleigh
- Santa is very generous, draw some presents on your sleigh
- Santa likes the sound of merry jingles, draw bells on the sleigh
- Santa works at night, put a moon in the sky

Calculate the points below:

The person with the most points wins!

- 10 points if the sleigh is in the middle of the paper
- 10 points if your tree us it the left of the sleigh and not touching it
- 15 points If you drew more than three snowflakes
- 25 points If you drew a star on the top of your tree
- 20 points If you have 2 or more ornaments actually on the tree
- 20 points If Santa is in the sleigh and not I the snow
- 20 points if you have 3 or more presents on your sleigh
- 15 points if you have drawn more than 2 bells
- 10 points if Santa has a hat
- 10 points if Santa has a beard
- 20 points If your moon is to the right of the paper
- 10 points If your moon is to the left of the paper
- 15 points If your moon is in the middle of the paper

Make sure you are aking your young people for feedback on the activity when you are finished! Maybe this could be the start of more art or teamwork based activities.
