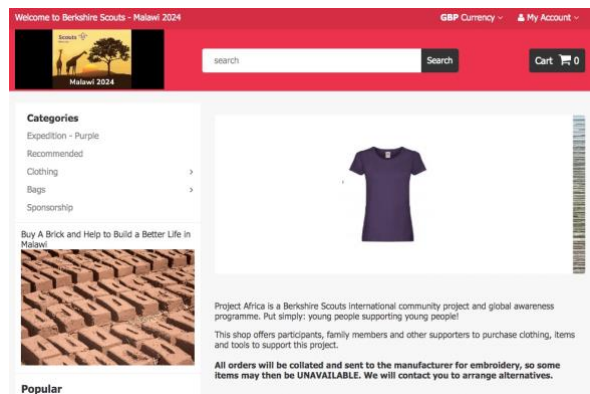


Allocation to groups
