

#### Large Kit Essentials

Holdall (suggest between 80-110ltrs, can have wheels, not a suitcase) Rucksack (<35ltrs) 3 season sleeping bag Cotton or silk sleeping bag liner Good sleeping mat (not a foam "yoga style") Inflatable pillow and pillowcase Towels Underwear **T-Shirts** Trousers Shorts Walking Boots Comfortable shoes to travel and relax in Water shoes (can be old trainers) Waterproofs (Coat & Trousers) Jumpers & Fleece Swimming Costume Clothes that can get wet


- There is a lot of information to manage and collect, Evboo is where we do that.
